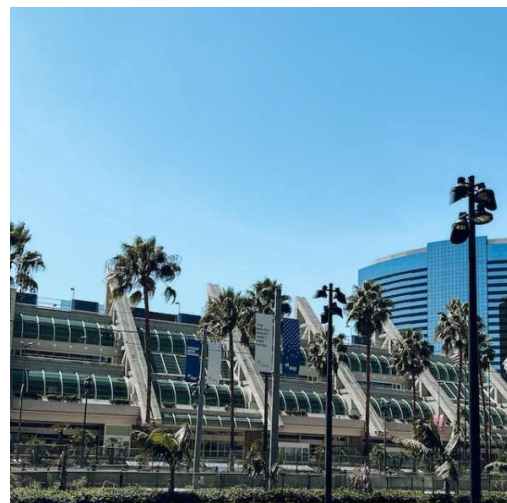
54th Research Seminar to Feature Special Panel Discussion
