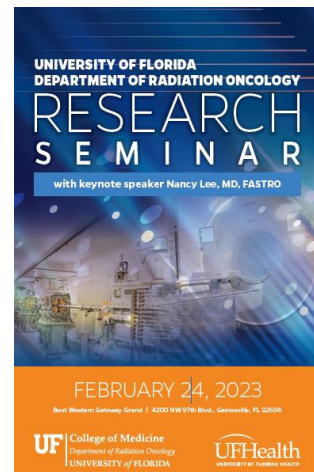

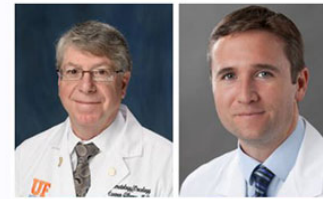
FBCF Provides Grant to Improve Self-Image of UF Breast Cancer Patients
